

VA Assessment Parent Portal Claim Codes in PVUE

Newport News Public Schools is pleased to announce a new method for parents to receive their child's Virginia Assessment Program test results. The Virginia Assessment Parent Portal is a web-based portal from the Virginia Department of Education for parents with children in grades 3 through 8 to access math and reading growth assessments (administered in fall and winter) and grades 3-12 SOL tests results (administered in May). 
Parents will need a Claim Code to create an account and view new/updated test results in the Parent Portal. To assist parents with obtaining their Claim Codes, Newport News Public Schools has provided this information for parents in ParentVUE.

LOGIN TO PARENTVUE

1. From a web browser, go to <http://sbo.nn.k12.va.us/parentvue/>. Parents may also use the ParentVUE App.
2. On the website, click **I am a Parent** and enter the User Name and Password for ParentVUE. Click **Login**. From the App, enter the User Name and Password and click **Login**.


SELECT A STUDENT

1. After logging into ParentVUE, click the **Student list** and select the appropriate student. Claim Codes are only provided for students in grades 3rd – 12th that have taken either the Growth Assessments in the Fall/Winter or the SOL's in May. Each administered test has its own unique Claim Code. If a student took both tests, then that student will have two codes.

2. On the left pane, select **Student Info**.



3. From a browser, once the Student Info screens open, scroll to the bottom of the page to the **Virginia Assessment Parent Portal**. The Growth Assessment and Spring SOL are listed, if applicable.

4. From the App, click **Student Info**. Once the Student Info screen opens click **Additional Information** in the bottom right hand corner. Then scroll to the bottom of the page to the **Virginia Assessment Parent Portal**. The Growth Assessment and Spring SOL are listed, if applicable.
